Convention Dancer Expectations:

- Dancers are required to attend all their convention classes throughout the weekend.
- Dancers must participate in the convention scholarship auditions.
 - On Sunday afternoon NUVO will be having a small "Scholarship Ceremony" in each ballroom. The last faculty
 of the day will announce the scholarships winners from each ballroom. (ie So whoever is teaching the juniors
 last, will announce all junior scholarship winners in that ballroom). They will only be acknowledging the
 winners on the microphone; the scholarships will not be handed out in the room.
- <u>All scholarships will be picked up at the registration desk by IDA Staff!</u> You will receive your scholarship paperwork the following week at the studio. The Convention will not be giving out individual awards/scholarships to dancers.

Convention Class Attire: Below you will find the required class attire for all classes during the weekend. We are attending convention as a Team and representing IDA, so we must look like a team.

- Dancers will be asked to wear a mask during convention classes as well as throughout the convention venue.
- Dancers are to wear their company jacket throughout the entire weekend. All dancers will need to bring a dance bag with them to carry their Jazz, Tap, Ballet & Sneakers for Hip Hop as well as other items.
- Dancers must wear dance attire in IDA Colors.
- All dancers must wear cover-up and shoes when outside the ballroom area. No tap shoes or bare feet outside ballrooms.
- Hair & Makeup: Dancers need to have their hair up and out of their face neatly done in a ponytail or bun. Dancers can wear light make up if they choose.

Call Time: Dancers are to arrive to home base with hair and make up done 2 hours prior* to competition to warm up and run their dances. Please walk around the venue / text Stefanie, Brittany or Nicole for home base information.

General Information:

- Competition Schedule will be "studio block" scheduling. There will be a 20-minute break in-between each studio block so competition staff can sanitize everything.
- Dressing rooms will be assigned, per studio. Details will be emailed closer to the event.

- Face Masks: For the competition, dancers can choose to wear a mask or not while they are competing, however it must be worn immediately before and after the routine (*Place in your IDA jacket backstage*). If your dancer chooses to wear a face mask it must be a "nude" face mask like the "Bloch B-safe" facemask and must be secured to their head. It cannot fall off during their performance.
- NUVO will have three virtual award ceremonies one on Thursday, Friday and one on Saturday (*this will include awards for all in-person and virtual routines from each day*). The awards can be viewed on NUVO's live webcast as we will not be allowing any spectators or dancers in the ballroom for the awards.
- Each Studio will have a unique "Studio Award Box" which will include all adjudicated, high score awards and scholarships from the weekend. <u>All awards will be picked up at the registration desk by IDA Staff!</u> You will receive your awards the following week at the studio.
