-CONVENTION INFORMATION-

Dancer Wristbands and Scholarship Numbers: Dancers are to wear their scholarship numbers during convention classes all day Saturday and Sunday.

- Dancer's will receive their wristbands / scholarship numbers, that they are to wear to Convention, at dancer check in on Saturday morning from IDA Staff.
- Please bring safety pins to pin your dancer's scholarship number onto their dance attire.
- Dancers will not need to wear convention wristband / scholarship numbers to Friday bonus classes.

Convention Arrival and Departure: Convention will have staggered start/end times. Dancers and families will need to follow those times to help with the flow of traffic in and out of the building/ballroom area.

- A parent / guardian is responsible to help their dancer find IDA dancer check in on Saturday to get their wristband / scholarship number as well as get them to their ballroom on Sat and Sun, check in with them during break times, and to meet them after convention hours.
